GIN MENU

LARIOS ROSE 37.5% **£2.75**

A striking pink version of Larios Mediterranean gin that has an intense strawberry aroma and is full of soft, fresh strawberry flavours.

OPIHR 40% **£3.25**

London Dry Gin made with botanicals from along the traditional spice route that led back to the UK. Indonesian Cubeb berries, Indian black pepper and Moroccan coriander are all used in this gin, launched by Quintessential Brands in 2013.

BROCKMANS 40% **£3.50**

Brockmans unique infusion of exquisite botanicals creates an intensely smooth gin with a distinctive original taste. The Bulgarian Coriander plays its part with an aromatic, almost gingery orange flavour, which marries beautifully with the softer, more rounded harmonies of blueberries and blackberries. This combination, together with the dry bitter/ sweet peel of Murician oranges prolong the deeper tones.

WARNER RHUBARB 40% **£4.25**

Bright rhubarb stalks upfront, with a brief flash of sourness. This is followed by an array of sweet spice: vanilla, nutmeg, and ginger, which add balance. Classic gin notes then come through, with resinous juniper and the spicy citrus of coriander and a lasting rhubarb crumble finish. Great paired with tonic, ginger ale or in cocktails.

GORDON'S 37.5% **£2.75**

Gordon's London Dry gin is carefully distilled using a secret recipe. The distinctive refreshing taste comes from the finest handpicked juniper berries & a selection of other botanicals. It's the taste that's made Gordon's the world's best-selling London Dry gin.

HENDRICKS 41.4% **£4.00**

Divinely smooth with character and a balance of subtle flavours, whose infusions of cucumber and rose petals create a wonderfully refreshing gin with a delightfully floral aroma. Made in Ayreshire, with 11 botanicals and 2 infusions, using two antique stills, in miniscule batches of only 450 Litres.

BOMBAY SAPPHIRE 40% **£3.25**

Created using the vapour Infusion process, Bombay Sapphire includes 10 precious botanicals that are held separate from the spirit in perforated copper baskets, and when the heated vapours rise, the distinctive flavour of the botanicals are released. The botanicals used are embossed onto the side of the iconic blue bottle

ELEPHANT 45% **£4.60**

Produced using the traditional method of one-shot distillation. The gins distinct nose first yields a subtle juniper aroma, with an undertone of mountain pine and other herbaceous notes. The taste is complex but strikingly smooth, encompassing floral, fruity and spicy flavours, which can be enjoyed both straight and in a cocktail.

TANQUERAY 43.1% **£3.25**

A traditional gin made from 4 botanicals, juniper, coriander, angelica and liquorice. It is the careful choice of ingredients that gives Tanqueray its distinctive taste and perfect balance.

BEEFEATER BLOOD ORANGE GIN 37.5% **£3.00**

Love fruity Gin? Yes, we do too. Beefeater have now created the rather wonderful Beefeater Blood Orange. If it's juicy bitter-sweet flavours that tickle your fancy then there's no need to look on. There's also the lovely, vibrant, colour to remind us that Summer is just round the corner.

WARNER ELDERFLOWER 40% **£4.25**

Complex nose with floral citrus and spice followed by unmistakable elderflower. Taste has a rich, velvety texture, spice at the beginning, and then notes of vanilla, nutmeg, and cardamom, with just a hint of chocolate. Full fruit and floral notes, including elderflower and citrus blossom. Perfect in summer cocktails or served with tonic.

J.J. WHITLEY VIOLET GIN 38.6% **£3.25**

Violet has become a particularly popular flavour within the world of gin, and J.J. Whitley have wasted no time joining in on the fun by launching their very own Violet Gin! The eponymous floral element is combined with a selection of eight additional botanicals along the lines of juniper, coriander, liquorice and angelica, and it boasts a pleasing pink hue.
